Want to be a Councillor? Application Deadline Extended Until June 15

A mailing delay held up the April/May edition of *PaACEP News*. Included with the newsletter was a councillor Interest fax-back form. Because of the delay, the deadline to submit the form has been extended until June 15.

This year, the chapter will send 14 councillors and at least 2 alternates to the ACEP Council Meeting that will be held in Seattle, October 6-7. To be considered, a member must meet one of the following criteria: serving as chair or a member of a PaACEP or ACEP committee; actively involved in the chapter or at the national level; serving as faculty for a PaACEP CME program; or a member who could represent the interests of members regarding a particular issue.

The ACEP Council is the national governing body of the College. All state chapters and sections (special-interest groups) are represented. The Council has the power to influence ACEP policy and to advise and instruct the board of directors. The Council also elects the ACEP Board of Directors.

The Council acts on resolutions submitted by chapters, sections, committees, the board, or individual members. The resolutions are first assigned to Reference Committees where councillors debate, and formulate recommendations for full Council discussion. Those adopted by Council are forwarded to the ACEP Board of Directors for action. Last year, the Council passed four PaACEP resolutions.

On June 18, the chapter's board of directors will select the councillors and alternates to represent the chapter. If you are interested in serving, an application can be found at www.paacep.org.
